

We continue to be grateful for both of these worship opportunities, realizing that not everyone is able to gather at church right now. As you prayerfully think about your worship options, please consider the following:

Am I at a higher risk for COVID-19?

- (Adults over 65 and those with underlying medical conditions)
- Do I work in close proximity with someone who has been sick or diagnosed with COVID-19 in the past 2 weeks?
- Do I currently have, or within the past 14 days have experienced, any of the following symptoms: Fever, cough, difficulty breathing, sore throat, muscle or chest pain, congestion, headache, fatigue, loss of smell or taste?
- Do I have an issue with wearing a mask during the entire time I am at church and socially distancing from others?
- Do I have questions and concerns about the safety precautions the church is taking?
- Do I have concerns about gathering with others for worship at this time?

If you answered "yes" to any of these, it may NOT be time for you to come back just yet. If you have any questions or concerns or have decided you will be worshipping in person, please contact the church office...and please keep praying for the day when we are all able to "make a joyful noise" under the same roof.
