than live in a world with a God like You.


#### "Coming Around"

## **Using Our Hearts and Minds During COVID Times...**

Our session and our new Transition Taskforce, which came on board when the work of the previous task force was done early fall, did a lot of praying and a lot of work in the last months of 2020. Our conversations and work revolved around listening to the needs of all our congregants while weighing the risk posed by COVID, according to the reports of healthcare and community organizations.

The Taskforce and the session came up with revised guidelines to use in making decisions about going back a phase and going forward a phase. The session decided to go back a phase as of January 7<sup>th</sup> in accordance with these new guidelines.

These are the revised guidelines for going FOR-WARD a phase:

The session will consider moving forward to Phase 2 when:

- The rolling average of new cases in a 7-day period is 30% or below, and
- The rolling average rate of test percent positive is 10% or below over a 14-day period, (information can be found on Hillsborough County Covid-19 dashboard), and
- The pastor feels current conditions present a safe work environment.
