POSITION SUMMARY: The primary focus for this position is to oversee Middle School and High School youth programs. These programs include worship, spiritual development, education, fellowship, discipleship, evangelism, missions, leadership development and encouragement for our youth. QUALIFICATIONS:

## Candidate must demonstrate:

- . a strong commitment to Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior;
- . the ability to relate to and communicate with young people in grades 6-12
- an interest in and commitment to developing quality relationships with youth and helping them to grow as disciples of Jesus Christ RESPONSIBILITIES:
- . Organize and coordinate a balanced approach to youth ministry that includes Bible study, discipleship training, outreach, recreation, fellowship, involvement in mission, and worship.
- . Organize and lead regular weekly meetings for middle school and high school youth to include Bible study, fellowship, and recreation. (Programming for Middle School and High School students is separate.)
- . Organize special events for Middle School and High School youth. (This would include retreats, service projects, fundraisers, fun events, etc.)
- . Coordinate annual participation in youth conferences or mission trips for Middle School and High School youth (e.g., Cedarkirk/Montreat conferences). Serve as point of contact for information, registration, and all logistical arrangements. Accompany youth to these events and arrange for additional adult participants as needed.
- . Develop effective publicity for youth activities through the bulletin, youth newsletter, monthly calendar, etc. This will include distributing information and fliers for events during the year.
- . Communicate effectively with youth, parents, and the Session regarding plans and activities (through e-mail, mailings, bulletin announcements, newsletter articles, meetings, etc.)
- . Meet periodically with parents and other interested members of the congregation to receive input.
- . Follow-up with those students who are not around and/or are not currently participating.
- > Develop a systematic program of outreach.
- . Formulate, submit, and manage a youth ministry budget.
- . Regularly attend PCof S worship services.
- . Determine and pursue common ministry goals with other Ministry
